Course SR 202 – How Do I Embrace His Ways

Lesson 3 Text

Since the way God heals is diverse, let's find the right door:

Without going into extensive detail, the Lord has provided healing for my family and me in all of the following ways at different times. Since the Lord is interested in wholeness for His saints, when healing takes place on the inside, many times physical healing follows.

- Declaring and believing, Isaiah 53:5, "...and by His scourging (or stripes) we are healed."
- Rebuking a demon and telling it to leave, Luke 9:42, "Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the boy, and gave him back to his father."
- Our own faith heals as in Matthew 9:22 like the woman with the hemorrhage, "But Jesus turning and seeing her said, daughter, take courage; your faith has made you well."
- The faith of others brings healing, like the man who was lowered through the roof in Mark 2:5-12, "And Jesus seeing their faith said to the paralytic, My son, your sins are forgiven. I say to you, rise, take up your pallet and go home. And he rose....."
- By laying on of hands. in Mark 16:18 Jesus said, ".....they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."
- Calling for the elders of the church. in James 5:13 it states, "Is there anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil

in the name of the Lord; and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him."

- In the above example, there is a correlation between forgiveness of sin and healing. Therefore, in Matthew 6:14 our sins will be forgiven when we forgive others, providing for our necessary healing.
- In the covenant relationship with Christ we can declare in the name of Jesus, Acts 3:6 which says, ".....in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene - walk!"
- Just a simple prayer as in Matthew 21:22, "And all things you ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive."
- Allowing someone to operate in the gift of healing and miracles for you as listed in I Corinthians 12:9-10.
- Physicians provide healing, Luke 5:31, "It is not those who are well who need a physician, but those who are sick." Jeremiah 8:22 also suggests physicians release healing.
- Herbs seem to provide nutrition where our soil has been denatured and has little value. In Genesis 1:29 it says, ".....I have given you every plant (herb) yielding seed that is on the surface of all the earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you."
- Renewing a covenant relationship with God during communion, and preferring or discerning the body of Christ brings healing as stated in I Corinthians 11: 23:32.
- There seems to be a significant correlation between our thinking, emotions and our health. In Proverbs 4:20-22 it says, "My son, give attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your sight; keep them in the midst of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and health to all their whole body."
